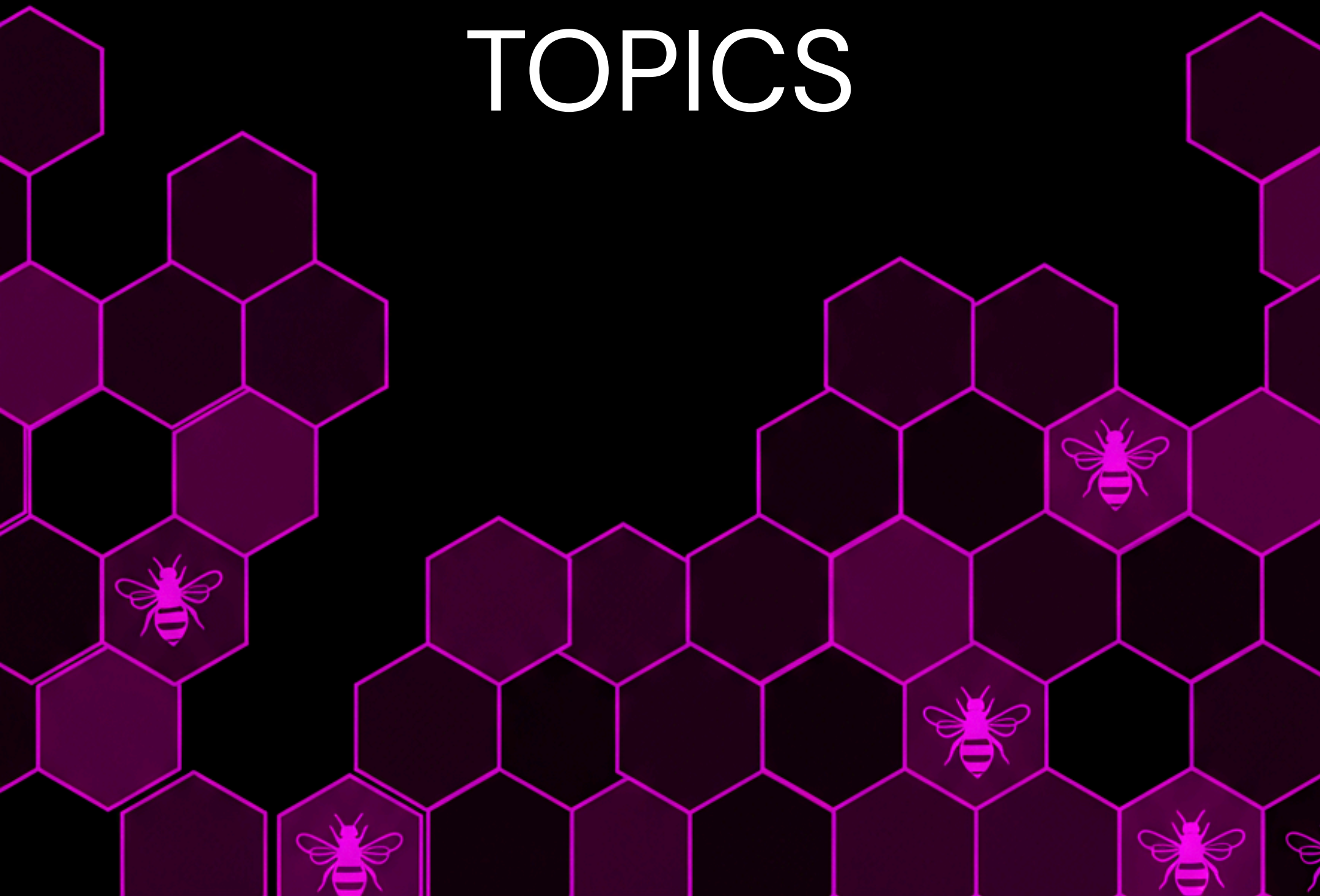

Through humor, honesty, and heartfelt storytelling, she equips audiences with practical tools to quiet their inner critic, rewrite old narratives, and lead from a place of worthiness and wisdom.
